

PLAYERS' INFO

Welcome to another season of innerclub. Each season we're getting more and more entries, and lots of new faces each time too which is fantastic. It does however mean we've had to make a few changes to make sure we can accommodate everyone.

CHANGES (for those who have played previously)

Most teams will have nine players listed. **Each week 6 players from each team will play.** To fit in the extra round of games each night, we're going to start the games at 6.30pm - we ask that all teams make the effort to get a match underway at that time. (Team points will be on offer)

The scoring will also change slightly. Previously we played a best of 5 sets, with each set to 11. **This time the games will be 3 sets, each set up to 15.** All three sets will be played, so even if a player is 2-0 ahead, the third set will still count for team points.

There'll be no mandatory stand down weeks for the number 1s in each team, due mainly to the high-calibre of the number 2s in each team this time around. Captains will still be asked to rotate their teams fairly through the series to give all players plenty of games. If you know the weeks you can't make it, let your captain know early on to make their job easier.

FAIR PLAY

Please remember this is a social event. A chance to meet other members of the club and have a good time playing squash. From time to time games will get a bit more serious, however good sportsmanship should always be shown to opponents, referees and other teams. This season we'll be rewarding good-sports with team bonuses and prizes.

REFEREEING

We recognise there are heaps of players new to the sport and plenty of others who still need help refereeing. We'll be making a big effort to help out anyone who needs to learn the rules, or get more confidence scoring and refereeing. If you need a hand with this or need to check some rules talk with your captain and team mates first, as they are there to help. We'll also have some senior players making themselves available for this each night.

FIRST ROUND

The first week starts on the 3rd February then every Thursday night until the last round. The final night will be played on Friday the 25th March - where we'll have our final prizegiving and social event.

ENTRY FEE

The Entry Fee is \$10 per person - please pay this to your captain on the first night you play. For non-members the entry fee is \$30 - however \$20 of this can be refunded if you join as a member of the club by the conclusion of the competition.

START TIME

Each week we will start at 6.30pm - it's important everyone gets there before this start time. This is a team event and even if you're not on first, you may need to referee, mark or cheer on your team mates. Let your captains know if you may be delayed, to make their job easier.

SUPPER AND PRIZEGIVING

At the end of each night there will be a light supper, and small prizegiving. See the attached draw for when you are on supper. Prizes will be awarded each night - however you must be present at the time to collect them if you have won. Team Red and Team Pink are on supper for the first round. If you are scheduled for supper, your team will also be responsible for ensuring the kitchen and lounge are clean and tidy at the end of the night.

SCORING

As mentioned above all matches are 3 sets, up to 15 points. Even if the score is 2-0, the third set will still be played.

COMPETITION POINTS

Every set you win will count towards your team's total. Plus bonus points will be awarded each week for the best outfits and the teams that show the best spirit, as well as starting on time and good sportsmanship - so it's a great chance to leap frog other teams on the points table just by supporting your team mates, dressing up and being a good sport.
